1	Pitfields	N1 Wheat	5	Wheat	Belgian style wheat beer brewed with coriander and a true Belgian wheat beer yeast. Pleasant mild banana and wheat malt aroma. Very lightly sweet, with banana and a touch of cloves. Mouthfeel was creamy and smooth	
3	Fat Cat	Stout Cat	4.6	Stout	An attractively-coloured deep, dark beer. The characteristic sweet, rich flavour of roast malt and molasses is well balanced with the pronounced hop flavour and aroma of classic English Pilgrim hops.	
		Cecil's Revenge	5.6	Gold	Brewed in memory of Cecil the Lion. Pale in colour and strong, with a bitter finish in flavour. Influenced, but not dominated, by the finest English Hops.	
		Marmalade	5.5	Gold	English pale malt is blended with speciality Belgian malt to add balance and a smooth, bitter finish	
2	Grain	Redwood	4.8	Red	Rich, amber and well-hopped premium bitter	
		Oak	3.8	Gold	Light and easy drinking bitter	
2	Dark Star	Revelation	5.7	Gold	A blend of Centennial, Liberty, Cascade, and Citra aroma hops by the sack full – then dry hopped during conditioning using our 'Hoptimizer' (Industrial sized hookah).	
		American Pale Ale	4.7	Gold	The yeast strain used for the brewing of the pale, dry American Ales is specially imported from the USA, along with Cascade and Centennial hops, to produce this pale ale. The low colour Maris Otter malt provides a perfect light colour and dryness to complement the crisp taste and full aroma of the hops	
2	Hopback	Citra	4	Gold	Brewed with English Pioneer and American Citra hops, this golden thirst-quenching ale has a lemony, grape-fruity aftertaste with a crisp dry bitterness, making your taste buds yearn for more.	
		Crop Circle	4.2	Gold	A very clean flaxen-coloured beer with wonderful thirst-quenching properties. The subtle blend of aroma and bittering hops give a crispness on the tongue which is delicately fruity, giving way to some dryness. The inclusion of some flaked maize in the grist subtly hints at crisp corn flavours. Ingredients: Optic malt, flaked maize, wheat malt. East Kent Goldings, Pioneer and Tettnang hops, coriander.	
2	Shortts	The Cure	3.6	Red	A traditional tawny bitter. Malty and moreish with a good balance of hops to malt making this a wonderful traditional best bitter.	
		Stummer	3.8	Amber	An amber ale. Easy drinking, light and hoppy bitter with a good moreish malty character.	
1	Golden Triangle	Black Hops IBA	4.6	Black	Black Hops is a distinctive Black "IPA" of 4.6% abv, brewed with East Anglian Malt and 3 types of American hops. Rather than the somewhat contradictory description of black "IPA" we are calling it an India Black Ale or IBA.	
8	Panther	Golden	3.7	Gold	A golden ale with a citrus flavour and a floral aroma. A light and refreshing ale with bite. Award winning (2015)	
		Honey	4	Gold	A gentle flowing brew with honey and malt throughout. Malt, caramel and hop. Amber coloured with a tapering bittersweet finale. Award winning 2014	
		Red	4.1	Red	Full flavoured brew. Solidly malty in both aroma and taste. Hops, and residual sweetness, provide balance. Award winning 2013	
		Pink	4	Wheat	A pink fruity wheat beer, refreshingly balanced with a bittersweet fruity finish.	
		Black	4.5	Stout	This dark ale is full flavoured, smooth and complex. It has a bittersweet balance that leads to a dry finish. Award winning 2015	
		Beast	5.5	Amber	An amber IPA, very refreshing, with floral and grapefruit notes from New Zealand hops.	
		Ginger	3.7	Wheat	Refreshing clean ginger wheat beer with a distinct fiery kick. Award winning 2013	
		Mild	3.3	Mild	A smooth malty character and notes of chocolate which gives this beer plenty of flavour and aroma.
